### **The Heber-Overgaard Fire District is recruiting qualified applicants for Full-time Firefighter employment.**

Heber-Overgaard is an unincorporated community in Navajo County which lies in the White Mountains of north eastern Arizona. It is located 55 miles east of Payson and 40 miles west of Show Low. The Heber-Overgaard Fire District encompasses an area of 102 square miles for fire suppression and 200 square miles for emergency medical response (EMS), Heber-Overgaard Fire District is also the primary ALS ambulance service provider for the area. The EMS response area includes 55 miles of state highway. The District's population consists of approximately 3,400 full-time residents which swells to three to four times that during the weekends, holidays and summer months.
